Junior Membership Information

A junior member is a person eighteen (18) years of age or under, who may be accepted for junior membership if he applicant shall furnish with his/her application and annual dues, his/her parent or guardian's written consent, and agreement that they will be responsible for the junior member's actions and liabilities while on the society's property and during society organized activities.

The junior membership year is from June 1 to May 31. Annual dues are equal to twenty-five (25) percent of the senior membership dues, and there is no initiation fee. The annual dues are a fixed fee and are not prorated over the membership year.

A junior member shall enjoy the privileges of the society within the framework set by the society and any modification the executive may from time to time prescribe. However, junior members are not eligible to vote or hold office in the society, nor shall they have any proprietary rights in the assets of the society.

A junior member may apply for senior or intermediate membership upon reaching his/her 19th birthday. Provided a junior member progresses to either intermediate or senior membership within one year of ceasing to be a junior member, no initiation fee will be payable.

Procedure

All applications shall be posted on the society notice board for a period of seven (7) days, during which period senior and honorary life members in good standing may register their disapproval in writing to the executive if they consider that the applicant's membership will be contrary to the best interests of the society.

The executive shall consider the application and may grant membership by a majority vote of the executive.

Upon acceptance into the society the new member will be notified.
