## **Logan Lake from Layritz Park**

From the parking lot at Layritz Park join the Glendale Trail that runs between the baseball fields. At the T-junction turn right and follow the trail along the side of the hill until you come to the next junction overlooking the Camosun College campus. Turn right and cross the road at the crosswalk. Follow the main trail around the top of the parking lot and down the hill to the pond.

- 1. At the bottom of the hill turn left and follow the trail across a footbridge don't take the short track up to Interurban on the left. Continue on to a road that just leads into a parking lot. From there, cross Interurban and walk up Viaduct Avenue. There's a bit of an uppy bit that is steep to begin with and then the slope becomes more gradual until you reach the entrance to Logan Park where there's a bench to park on. In Logan Park you can go straight on or take the right hand trail, with both routes leading to the access trail to Hector Road (fences on both sides).
- 2. At Hector you have a choice: for a shorter walk turn right and follow Hector to Interurban or for a longer walk turn right and follow Hector around to Liberto Road and turn left down that road. However, there's a side route you can take to a good viewpoint over Trevlac Pond. To take this route, turn right on Calvert (that's "Trevlac" backwards) and you'll immediately see a pathway off to the right. A short distance down that trail you come to a bit of the trail that is steep and narrow don't try this if it's been frosty or you're not too good on narrow paths overlooking a bit of a drop! If you follow the main trail for about 300m you'll come to a bench overlooking the pond on the right hand side. Rest and return the way you came!
- 3. At the end of Liberto Road you'll turn right on to Ivor Road and follow that around until it reaches Conway Road (Hector Road but with a different name) and turn right towards Interurban.
- 4. Once you reach Interurban you'll see a pathway to your right which parallels the main road. Walk along there for less than a 100m until you see a route on the left from which you can see Interurban. Cross the main road to the junction with Markham Road. Just a few metres up Markham on the left had side you'll see a trail that leads up and around Camosun's trades training building.
- 5. Follow the trail until you come to a junction where you turn right and down to the edge of the parking lot that you skirted on the way out. Follow the Glendale Trail back to the parking lot.
